These conditions are a safety concern for everyone – particularly for those with limited mobility and service providers. Keeping sidewalks free of snow and ice is important in keeping Edmontonians moving safely. Failure to maintain your sidewalks could result in a \$100 fine plus potentially any cleanup costs. Come and pick up free sand at the hall - just bring your bucket!

### DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN RINK AREA & PLAYGROUND

In past years, the Woodcroft skating rink (Arena) was seldom used during the summer, so we "turned a blind eye" to dog owners

using the area to allow their dogs to run free, provided they did not leave a mess. However, we have since made a significant capital investment (\$\$) to develop the beach volleyball courts and we continue to commit a significant portion of our annual budget to maintain the ice-skating surfaces. It is important that this area be well maintained and kept free of any contaminants.

For this reason, we ask that dog owners refrain from bringing dogs into the arena area in the future. A person bringing a dog onto parkland remains subject to every provision contained in the Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw, #13145. Dogs must be kept at least 10 metres away from any playground, sports field or picnic site at all times. This bylaw was implemented to protect the health and wellbeing of parkland users.


