Sidewalk Safety: With spring around the corner we want to remind everyone that the nice weather brings out more of our residents to our sidewalks and crossing streets. Please watch for children and other pedestrians. This is a common time for the freeze/thaw cycle. There is free sand at the community centre, please ensure your sidewalks are safe.

Skating: With the nicer weather, watch our website and/or follow us on Facebook to check on the status of our rink. We will keep the rink open as long as it is safe to do so.

No off-leash area in rink: DO NOT use the rink as an off-leash dog park. We have ice in the winter and sand in the spring/summer for volleyball. It is unhygienic for the volleyball players if the sand is used as a dog park. Dogs must be kept at least 10 metres away from any playground, sports field or picnic site at all times, according to Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw, #13145.
