We want to encourage an active neighbourhood and with the weather turning nicer, we want to ask all residents and their guests to travel with precaution through our neighbourhood. Children are outside more, crossing to the playground, school yards or just visiting neighbours, there are more cyclists on our streets, more pedestrians, more outdoor sports in our community, and people walking to the local businesses, please watch for everyone as we enjoy the warmer weather.

**TD Park People Grant:** We are happy to be one of the lucky recipients to receive the TD Park People Grants. We received \$2000 to help us host great events in our community and park space, thanks to TD Bank. Please check inside this newsletter for the many great events coming up.

**Dog Owner Reminder:** A reminder to all dog owners that our rink/volleyball courts are NOT approved off leash areas. We have beach volleyball courts with sand in our rink and it is NOT to be used as an off leash dog area.

#### The City Bylaw for Dog Owners states:

- (1) Unless otherwise permitted by this bylaw, no person shall allow any animal under their control, or for which they are responsible, to be on Parkland.
- (2) A person may have a Dog on Parkland so long as the Dog is: (a) leashed and on an improved trail or an unimproved trail; (b) leashed and on a boulevard;
- (c) leashed and in an area governed by signage permitting dogs; or (d) in a designated off leash area; but only if the dog is, at all times, kept at least 10 metres from any developed playground or picnic site.
